## 100 Days: Ukraine and Her People Remain Unbroken

Leading up to February 24, 2022, Vladimir Putin had emptied the public treasury of the Russian Federation to outspend Ukraine's military: with a twofold advantage in land forces, ten times the aircraft and five times the armored fighting vehicles, the Russian dictator sought a quick and easy victory over Ukraine and her unbreakable people.

The Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA), the largest representation of Americans of Ukrainian descent, commends Ukraine's heroes for their service and valor throughout these past 100 days. Ukraine continues to accomplish what the rest of the world deemed impossible: refusing to submit to the genocidal campaign of one of the world's largest militaries.

UCCA maintains that it is in America's national interest to see Ukraine emerge from this war a sovereign and democratic state, in charge of its own foreign

weapons, economic assistance and humanitarian aid.


Through the combined advocacy of the Ukrainian American community and our allies, the United States has provided more than \$7.3 billion in security assistance for training and equipment to help Ukraine since 2014. This includes more than \$4.6 billion since Russia's launched its premeditated, unprovoked, and brutal war against Ukraine on February 24.

In the past 100 days alone, UCCA has successfully advocated for:

- The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2022, enacted March 15, which included \$13.6 billion “to address Russia’s invasion of Ukraine and the impact on surrounding countries.”
- The Ukraine Democracy Defense Lend-Lease Act of 2022, enacted May 9, authorizing the administration, through fiscal year 2023, to lend or lease military equipment to Ukraine and other Eastern European countries.
- The Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2022, enacted May 21, which will “provide more than \$40 billion in emergency funding to support the Ukrainian people and defend global democracy in the wake of Russia's unprovoked attack on Ukraine”

The law-abiding international community of free nations is united today more than ever before, across borders and seas, in its goal for a free, sovereign, democratic and prosperous Ukraine.
