Earlier today 11 U.S. lawmakers co-sponsored a so-called "Ukraine Fatigue" Resolution. If passed, the Resolution would proclaim, "It is the sense of the House of Representatives that... the United States must end its military and financial aid to Ukraine."

Demonstrating a shocking ignorance of foreign affairs, this announcement fails to recognize that by supporting Ukraine, we are not only defending the post-World War Two rules-based order, but preventing a potential conflagration on the entire European continent which would surely drag the U.S. into a world war.

The proposed resolution also omitted any mention of the unprovoked, genocidal military assault against Ukraine, launched nearly a year ago, as well as the many Crimes Against Humanity perpetrated in Ukraine and which are currently under investigation by the International Criminal Court in the Hague.

In fact, the enemy's name was only mentioned once in the resolution: as a recipient of Ukraine's refugees.

The Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA), the largest representation of Ukrainians in America, expresses its justifiable outrage at the sentiment behind the resolution and the accompanying statement. Instead of calling out our mutual enemy, the proposed resolution shames the men and women of Ukraine who continue to stand on the frontlines of democracy for receiving U.S. assistance.
