## UCCA calls for Ukraine Membership at NATO Vilnius Summit

The Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA), the representative organization of nearly two million Americans of Ukrainian descent, calls upon the United States to support #UkraineInNATO at the July 11-12 NATO Summit in Vilnius, Lithuania, and for the Alliance to accelerate critical security assistance for Ukraine to win this unprovoked, genocidal war of russian aggression swiftly and decisively.

For decades, NATO served as an effective bulwark against Soviet expansion. That the russian federation has emerged as a similar aggressor state, leading to a destabilization of the European continent, is proof of

NATO's continued importance for both the United States and Europe as a safeguard against continued russian expansionism. In addition to the full-fledged military invasion of Ukraine, the repeated serious russian provocations directed against neighboring NATO and non-NATO nations in the region endanger not only the sovereignty and territorial integrity of European allies, but the future viability of all trans-Atlantic security structures.

Over the past 16 months of russia's full-fledged aggression within Ukraine, the brave men and women of Ukraine have taken it upon themselves to defend the NATO's eastern flank, making their nation a de facto member of the Alliance. By defending democracy against tyranny, Ukraine has also exhibited tangible interoperability with NATO standards and has completed its transition from a soviet to a NATO-style military.

The recent political tumult and instability in russia only reinforces the rationale for the United States and our NATO allies to provide Ukraine with all the weapons necessary to be victorious in this unjust war. In line with UCCA's previous statements supporting Ukraine's NATO aspirations since the 2008 Summit in Bucharest, UCCA also expects that during the upcoming Vilnius Summit, the Alliance will provide Ukraine with a clear commitment for Ukraine's NATO membership.




