Hawai'i Update - #MauiStrong

Multiple wildfires have been burning on the island of Maui since the evening of August 8, 2023. The island, beloved for its world-famous beaches, the sacred 'Īao Valley, and the magnificent sunrise and sunset from Haleakalā National Park, is today the site of the deadliest fire in the United States in over 100 years. Lāhainā, site of the ancient capital of the Kingdom of Hawai'i, is the most impacted area on the island. As you can imagine, a fire of this magnitude will have a long-lasting effect on local businesses, resorts and — most importantly — the people who call Lāhainā home.



Last week, we informed you that after a long process, UCCA was notified by the State of Hawai'i regarding UCCA's registration as a charitable organizations allowed to fundraise in the state. UCCA representatives and residents of Honolulu had worked since the start of summer towards this final designation in advance of their community's planned Independence Day Event, on 26 August.

With an estimated 2,200 buildings destroyed and at least 1,300 people missing, local event organizers and UCCA will dedicate a financial donation

from any funds raised at the August event in Honolulu towards local aid to Maui relief.

In the course of this 9 year genocidal war against Ukraine, Ukrainian Americans have not wavered in assisting our fellow Americans, as evidenced by local UCCA fundraisers for natural disaster relief affecting communities in Texas, Florida, and others.


