The 78th session of the UN General Assembly will open the first day of the [high-level General Debate](#) on Tuesday, 19 September 2023. World leaders will gather to engage in the annual high-level General Debate under the theme, “Rebuilding trust and reigniting global solidarity: Accelerating action on the 2030 Agenda and its Sustainable Development Goals towards peace, prosperity, progress and sustainability for all.”

Addressing the Morning Session on Tuesday will be both U.S. President Joseph R. Biden, Jr., and President of Ukraine, Volodymyr Zelenskyy.

The Morning Session is scheduled to begin at 9:00am ET, with President Biden as the 4th speaker of the morning. Following President Biden and Polish President Andrzej Duda (#7), President Zelenskyy will be the 12th invited world leader to speak following UN Secretary-General António Guterres and Dennis Francis of Trinidad and Tobago, President of the General Assembly at its seventy-eighth session. Given that each speaker can speak for as long or short as they see fit, those choosing to tune in after 9:00am ET should pay attention for President Zelenskyy's address sometime after 12:00pm ET.

The White House has announced a request to Congress for an additional \$24 billion in supplemental appropriations for Ukraine. Media outlets are reporting that the presidential request would include \$13.1 billion in additional security and military, with an additional \$8.5 billion for economic and humanitarian assistance to Ukraine.

Currently, the supplemental request is being debated in the U.S. Congress on whether to include the \$24 billion appropriations in a continuing resolution (CR) to avert a federal shutdown. The Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA) and its Washington, DC public affairs bureau – the Ukrainian National Information Service (UNIS) – urge you to contact your elected officials to express your support for the supplemental assistance to Ukraine.

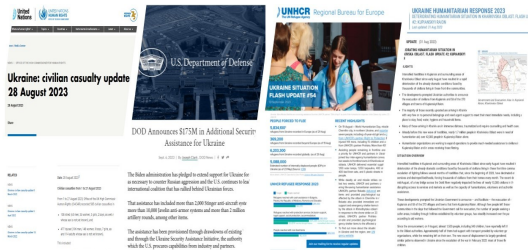
