

# Presidents Biden and Zelenskyy to Address United Nations



The 78th session of the UN General Assembly will open the first day of the <a href="https://high-level.google.com/high-level.google.


Addressing the Morning Session on Tuesday will be both U.S. President Joseph R. Biden, Jr., and President of Ukraine, Volodymyr Zelenskyy.

The Morning Session is scheduled to begin at 9:00am ET, with President Biden as the 4th speaker of the morning. Following President Biden and Polish President Andrzej Duda (#7), President Zelenskyy will be the 12th invited world leader to speak following UN Secretary-General António Guterres and Dennis Francis of Trinidad and Tobago, President of the General Assembly at its seventy-eighth session. Given that each speaker can speak for as long or short as they see fit, those choosing to tune in after 9:00am ET should pay attention for President Zelenskyy's address sometime after 12:00pm ET.
