# **UCCA REMINDS UKRAINIAN AMERICANS TO VOTE IN EVERY ELECTION**

Voter turnout during off-year elections is historically low. This TUESDAY, 7 NOVEMBER, Americans in certain states will have the opportunity to participate in gubernatorial and state legislative elections, mayoral races,

and as well as numerous citizen initiatives and a variety of other local offices on the ballot.

To maximize political attention on the question that matters most to you - Ukraine's victory over foreign invaders - supporters of Ukraine need to show up at the polls in bigger and bigger numbers no matter how big or small the election can seem. Political parties gather data on all of us, ranging from purchasing history, social media behavior as well as Census information, in order to get a fuller understanding about potential voters in 2024. Background data for those individuals who regularly vote in elections is diligently tracked and then fed back to the national party registries. Regardless of which individual candidates win on the local, state or federal level, communities with increased voter participation, especially in off-years when overall turnout is depressed, will be acknowledged after the election as a voting bloc that needs to be addressed based on the data.

## A Critical Push To #SupportUkraine

In September, Congress averted a potential government shutdown with the passage of a stopgap funding bill to keep the government open through mid-November. Unfortunately, that stopgap measure did not include additional funding for Ukraine.

On Thursday, 19 October, President Biden addressed the nation from the Oval Office, to <u>announce his request of Congress</u> for supplemental funding to support our allies in Ukraine and Israel, as well as border security and other international concerns. Unfortunately, <u>it remains unclear whether Congress will approve</u> this much-needed budget request.

<u>National Information Service</u> (UNIS) – urge you to contact your elected officials to express your support for the supplemental assistance to Ukraine.



Dear Speaker Pro Tempore:

Over the coming weeks, the Administration looks forward to continued engagement with members of both parties to reach a comprehensive, bipartisan agreement to fund the Government and invest in critical national priorities. As part of that process, the Congress has an opportunity and obligation to advance our national security by addressing critical needs that should earn bipartisan support. Today, I am writing to provide you with the President's request for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 emergency supplemental funding for these key national security priorities.

(FY) 2024 emergency supplemental funding for these key national security priorities.

This request reflects how, under President Biden's leadership, the U.S. has marshalled a robust response to Putin's bruttal invasion of Ukraine and is now coming to the aid of our ally Israel. As we replenish our stocks of weapons, we are partnering with the U.S. defense industry to increase our capacity and meet the needs of the United States and our allies both now and in the future. This supplemental request invests over \$50 billion in the American defense industrial base—ensuring our military octimuses to be the most ready, capable, and best equipped fighting force the world has ever seen. The funding will expand production lines, strengthening the American economy and creating new American jobs. This request also addresses the global humanitarian impacts of Russia's brutal invasion of Ukraine and of Hamas' horrific attacks on Israel, including by extending humanitarian assistance to civilians in Gaza. The request provides resources to the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund to ensure we can provide an alternative to occraive financing provided by the People's Republic of China (PRC), and its supports U.S. capabilities and initiatives that bolster security and stability in the Inde-Pacific. Finally, it blosters our Nation's border enforcement and will help stop the flow of fentanyl coming into the United States.

First, the United States unequivecally condemns the horrific terrorist attacks by Hamas in Israel. More than 1.300 innocent civilians were murdered, including at least 32 American citizens. Additionally, there are 12 Americans unaccounted for, some of whom we know to be held hostage by Hamas. President Bielen directed his Administration to take immediate action and do everything we can to ensure the government of Israel has what in teeds. To build on that support, foodsy the Administration is requesting funding to aid Israel's defense, an unprecedented commitment to Israel's security. This funding will increase security assistance for Israel as it seeds to recreabilist territorial security and deterrence and will bolster Israel's ability to protect itself. The request also includes humanitarian support to provide life-awing humanitarian assistance in Gaza and support Palestinian refugees in the West Bank and surrounding areas.
