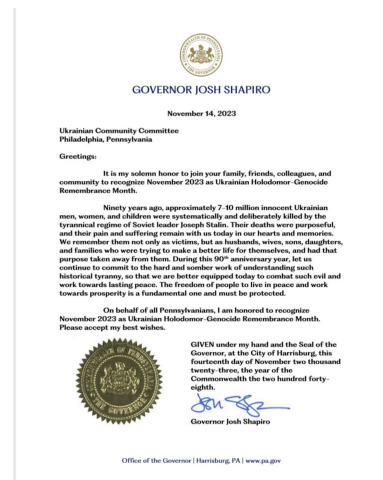
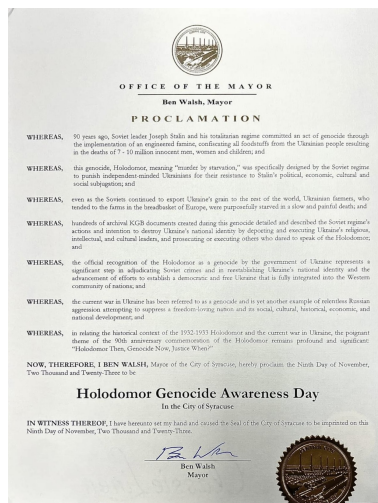

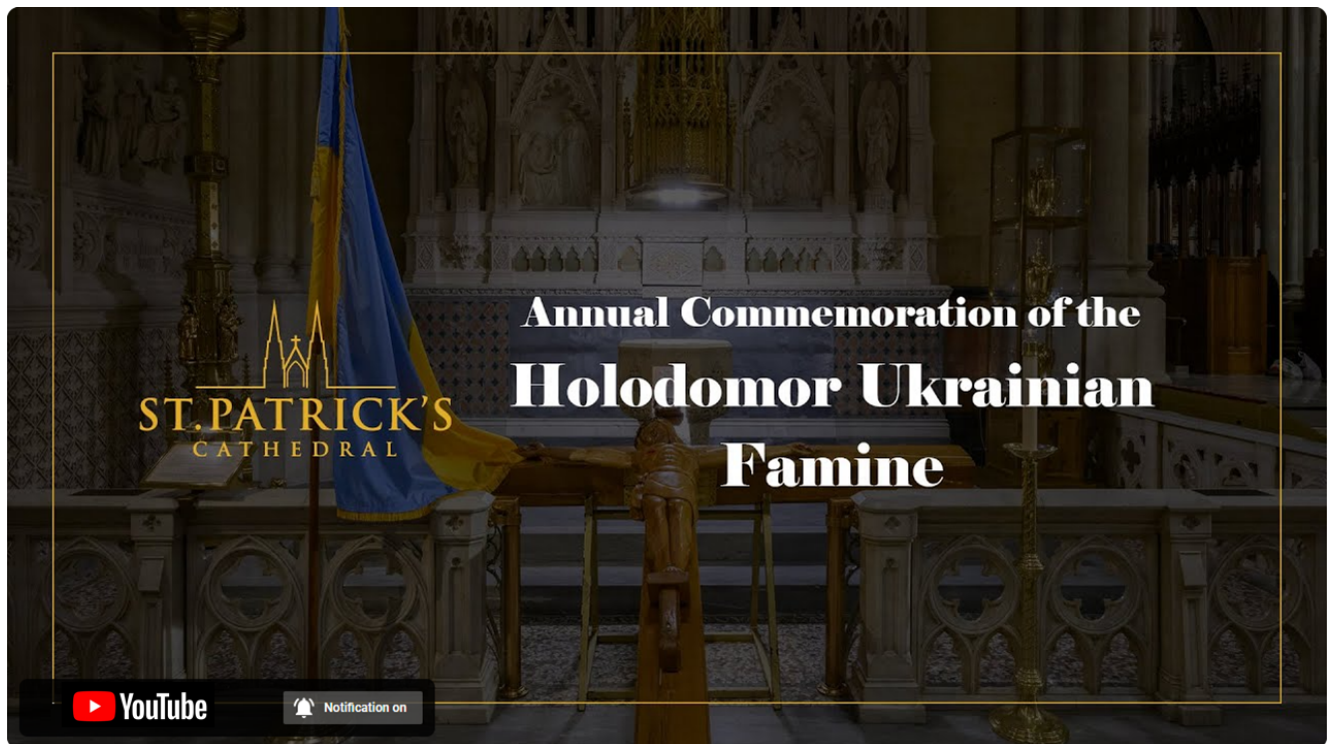

## Prayer Vigil and Community Gathering

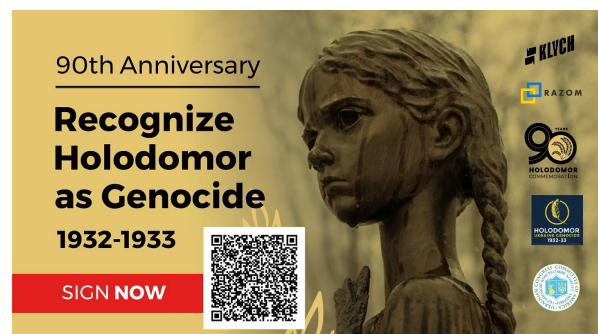
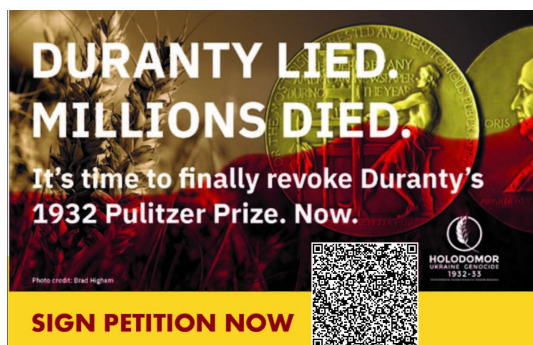

On **Friday, 17 November**, the [United Ukrainian Organizations of Ohio](#) will host Amb. Oksana Markarova at a series of events examining the Holodomor of 1932-33. Beginning at 11:30am, a forum will be held [at the City Club of Cleveland](#), followed by a 2:00pm discussion at [Cleveland State University](#), and concluding with a 6:30pm Prayer Vigil at [St. Vladimir Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral](#) in Parma, OH. Accompanying the Ambassador at these events will be both former US Senator Rob Portman and UCCA President Andriy Futey.



On [Saturday, 18 November](#), the Ukrainian American community in New York will honor the innocent victims of the Holodomor Famine Genocide. Beginning at 10:30am, participants will gather at [St. George Ukrainian Catholic Church](#) (at 30 East 7th Street) for a solemn procession. The Memorial March will end at [St. Patrick's Cathedral](#) (at 50th Street and 5th Avenue), where a requiem service sung by the [Ukrainian Chorus Dumka of New York](#) will take place beginning at 1:00pm. Following the service, remarks will be delivered by UCCA President Andriy Futey, Amb. Oksana Markarova, and Amb. Sergiy Kyslytsya among other dignitaries.
