# UCCA President Visits Recipients of Rachael Ray's Humanitarian Aid Deliveries for Ukraine's Children

During UCCA President Andriy Futey's recent trip to Ukraine, additional visits were arranged outside of the capital to meet with our partners on the ground.



As an Ambassador for the <u>UNBROKEN National Rehabilitation Center</u> in Lviv, UCCA's Futey met with the Center's leadership to discuss priority projects that can assist the wounded.





UCCA's president also visited the <u>St. John Bosco Educational & Vocational Center</u>, with whom <u>Rachael Ray</u>, together with UCCA, has <u>outfitted an entire kitchen</u>, which enabled her to <u>conduct master cooking classes</u> while feeding the students and orphans. During this return visit, UCCA's Futey discussed future program ideas to assist the school and the orphans with Fr. Andriy Bodnar.





UCCA's president also reviewed a recent delivery of medical equipment, including a precision surgical microscope specifically designed for use in ophthalmic applications.

With special thanks to Bohdan Cherniawski from the <u>Canada-Ukraine</u> <u>Foundation</u>, the <u>Ukrainian Medical Association of North America</u> (UMANA), and <u>Project C.U.R.E.</u>, the recent purchase of this vitally-needed microscope as a result of UCCA's and Rachael Ray's partnership, instantly enabled dozens of medical procedures in just a few days.

# UCCA Phoenix Members Witness Signing of Historic Agreement





On 14 November, members and leadership of the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America Phoenix Branch represented the Ukrainian American community of Arizona at the signing of a historic agreement between Ukraine and the <u>Arizona Defense & Industry Coalition (AZDIC)</u> which will aid Ukraine's defense capabilities and contribute to joint projects for the protection of critical infrastructure.

The signing event in Phoenix, AZ, included Dmytro Kushneruk, Consul General of Ukraine in San Francisco, Vasyl Teterya, Deputy Minister of Internal Affairs of Ukraine, Sergii Demydenko, CEO of Rebuild Ukraine Synergy, and Phoenix UCCA Board members Mike Baraban, Rick Tkachuk, Chrystia Boyko, and Irene Renstrom, among others. The Phoenix chapter was also represented the next day at a similar event in Tucson, AZ. You can read more about the signing event in Phoenix on the Global Defense & Industry Coalition website.



Earlier this summer, an <u>AZDIC delegation traveled to Ukraine</u> to identify Reconstruction, Food Security and Defense Technology needs. This led to a an agreement being finalized in Washington, D.C., which will help streamline Ukraine's acquisition of essential resources for its defense, while aiding efforts to rebuild the nation while still in conflict. The event in Washington, D.C., <u>coincided with President Zelenskyy's visit</u>, and was attended by U.S. Senator Mark Kelly of Arizona and senior staff from the office of U.S. Senator Kyrsten Sinema, also of Arizona.



Throughout the U.S., support for Ukraine has mobilized the defense industrial base in ways that haven't been seen in decades. Contractors are making, among other things, the 155 mm artillery round, the Guided Multiple Launch Rocket System, and Stinger and Javelin missiles. In November, the DOD released details related to how the defense industrial base in more than 37 states is contributing to the U.S. security commitment to Ukraine, with some \$3.3 billion committed in funding across 18 states to help defense contractors both expand and modernize existing production lines and add new lines entirely.
