The \$61.4 billion supplemental request for Ukraine is currently being discussed in Congress. Combined with funding for Israel, Taiwan, and U.S. border security, the overall \$111 billion supplemental bill depends upon your advocacy and outreach efforts.

## **HOW TO CONTACT CONGRESS:**

- 1. Click <u>www.senate.gov</u> to search for your state and its two senators;
- Click <u>www.house.gov</u>, input your zip code to search for your Representative; and
- 3. Copy and paste sample letter below into the contact form and press send.

It is essential for **constituents** to contact their Representative and two Senators. As congressional offices tally correspondence they receive on issues of concern to constituents, your communication with your elected officials will denote the importance and urgency of additional security assistance to Ukraine.

## Dear Senator/Representative:

As a constituent in [state/district], I urge you to support Ukraine, specifically the proposed \$61.4 billion supplemental request to aid Ukraine's territorial defense. This crucial assistance benefits Ukraine, the United States, and the entire Free World.

15 November Commemoration in Harrisburg, PA



On Wednesday, November 15, 2023, Ukrainian Americans from the Philadelphia Metropolitan Area, the Lehigh Valley, and from communities large and small in Central and Northeast Pennsylvania gathered at the State Capitol Building in Harrisburg, PA, to mark the 90th anniversary of the Holodomor-Genocide with a day of commemorative events. A Proclamation signed by Governor Josh Shapiro and Citations by the State Senate and House of Representatives, both recognizing November 2023 as "Ukrainian Holodomor-Genocide (Genocide by Hunger) Remembrance Month," were presented to representatives of Ukrainian American community organizations.

Remarks were made by <u>State Senator Maria Collett</u>, State Representatives Liz Hanbidge and Steve Malagari, UCCA Vice President Michael Sawkiw, Jr., Ulana Mazurkevich of the Philadelphia Ukrainian American Community Committee, and the Honorary Consul of Ukraine in Philadelphia, Iryna Mazur, as well as Governor Shapiro's representative, Ms. Kristine Paradise. The efforts of Andrij Chornodolsky, Attorney Eugene A. Luciw, Professor Paula Holoviak, Ms. Marianna Tretiak, and the Very Rev. ## 26 November Commemorations in Honolulu, HI



On 25 November, members of <u>Hawaii Stands With Ukraine</u> led a Holodomor Memorial Walk through the streets of Honolulu on the island of Oʻahu, Hawaiʻi. The following day, parishioners of <u>St. Sophia Ukrainian Greek</u> <u>Catholic Church on Oahu</u> and Ukrainian community members gathered at the Mary, Star of the Sea Church in Honolulu to pray at for the millions of innocent Ukrainians who died of the artificially created famine imposed by Stalin and his genocide 90 years ago and for the souls of those more recently killed by russian aggression. 




