📣 UKRAINE SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST - CALL/WRITE YOUR REPRESENTATIVE! 📣

Earlier today, the House of Representatives Appropriations Committee introduced a national security supplemental bill for Ukraine. The bill provides \$61b in assistance to Ukraine, including a clause that calls upon the President to "transfer long range Army Tactical Missile Systems to the Government of Ukraine to assist the Government of Ukraine in defending itself and achieving victory against the russian federation [sic]." Votes are scheduled for Saturday evening in the U.S. House of Representatives.
