1. Click www.senate.gov to search for your state and your two senators; and,
2. Copy and paste the sample letter below into the contact form and press send.

***** A VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE:** The previous vote in the U.S. Senate in February 2024 for the national security supplemental bill was 70-29. Your communication with your Senators will denote the urgency of additional security assistance to Ukraine and to ensure a higher vote in favor of Ukraine!

SAMPLE CORRESPONDENCE:
