On 24 February 2022, Russia began a full-scale, unprovoked military invasion of Ukraine and the world was irrevocably changed. This **19-20 November**, Ukrainians around the world will be marking 1000 of heroic defense with the hashtags **#1000DaysOfResilience**, **#1000DaysOfCourage**, **#1000DaysAgainstTyranny** and others. UCCA asks our Local Branches, Member Organizations and General Membership to actively engage their local governments in marking this solemn anniversary with local and statewide commemorations, and, if possible, for local government buildings or landmarks to be lit up in Ukraine's national colors of blue and yellow. Additionally, community prayer services or candlelight vigils should be organized at some point within a 48-hour period

beginning 19 November, and coordinated with media coverage in your local area.

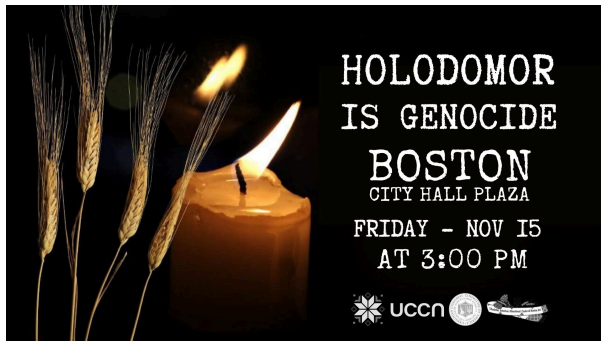

We ask you to continue to circulate information about this crime of genocide to your respective members, friends and family during this annual period of commemoration.

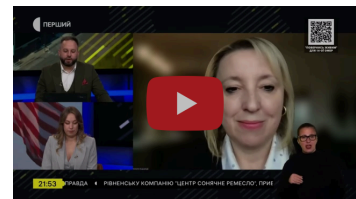
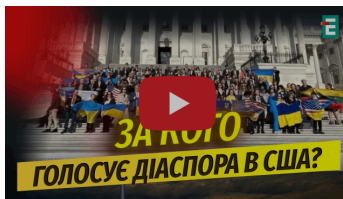
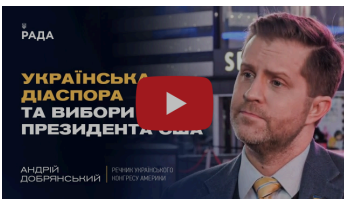

Congress is currently in recess and elected officials are back in their respective states and districts until after Election Day. Before the congressional recess, Rep. Richard Fitzpatrick (R-PA) - co-chair of the Congressional Ukraine Caucus, and Sen. Richard Blumenthal (D-CT), introduced the **STAND WITH UKRAINE ACT OF 2024** in their respective chambers, which would codify many elements of the U.S. - Ukraine Bilateral Security Agreement signed in June 2024. Highlights of the bill include the following:

- Modernizing Ukraine's Security Capabilities
- Prioritizing Excess Defense Article Transfers for Ukraine
- Fast-Tracking Sales to Ukraine under Foreign Military Sales Program
