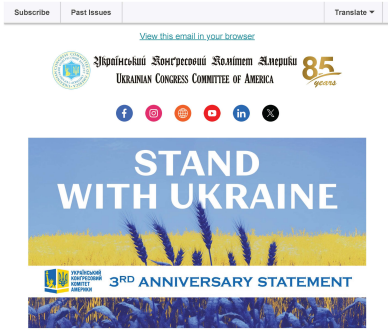

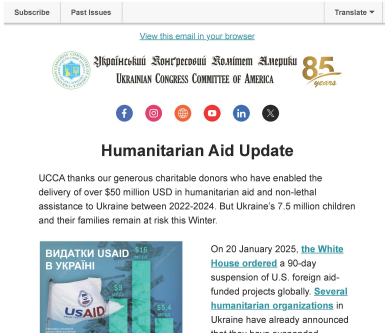

On 24 February 2022, Russia launched a full-scale, unprovoked military invasion of Ukraine, a major escalation of a war which started in 2014. Today, Ukrainians and supporters of Ukraine gather to mark the 3rd anniversary of when rockets began raining down on Kyiv for the first time since the Nazi invasion of Ukraine. The Ukrainian Congress Committee of America, representing Americans of Ukrainian descent since 1940, expresses its profound gratitude to all those who have laid down their lives in defense of our common shared values of human rights and democracy, and prays for a peaceful repose for the souls of the innocent. Over the course of the past 3 years, the world has borne witness to Russia's cruelty, bloodthirstiness, and its unconcealed hatred for the Ukrainian

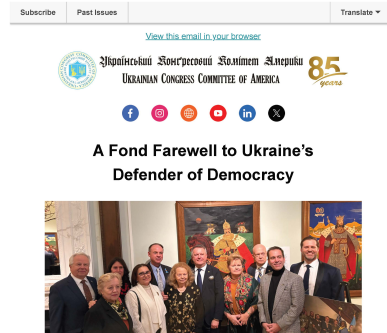


Humanitarian Aid Update

UCCA thanks our generous charitable donors who have enabled the delivery of over \$50 million USD in humanitarian aid and non-lethal assistance to Ukraine between 2022-2024. But Ukraine's 7.5 million children and their families remain at risk this Winter.



On 20 January 2025, the White House ordered a 90-day suspension of U.S. foreign aid-funded projects globally. Several humanitarian organizations in Ukraine have already announced that they have suspended operations, including assistance to war veterans and internally displaced people. According to data aggregated at the Slovo i Dilo portal, USAID funded projects in Ukraine worth \$9 billion in 2022, \$16 billion in 2023, and \$5.4 billion in 2024. Concerns remain that the U.S. now plans to end USAID as an independent agency altogether.



A Fond Farewell to Ukraine's Defender of Democracy



Friends and colleagues of the Permanent Representative of Ukraine to the United Nations, Ambassador Sergiy Kyslytsya, gathered at the Ukrainian Institute of America in New York City on 22 January 2025, Ukraine's Day of Unity. On this date in 1918, Ukraine's independent government - the Central Rada - issued its Fourth Universal, declaring the full and unqualified independence of Ukraine. This was followed a year later with the 'Act of Union' (Akt Zluky), merging the Ukrainian People's Republic (UNR) and the Western Ukrainian People's Republic (ZUNR) into a single sovereign and independent state of the Ukrainian people.
