📣 U.S.MILITARY ASSISTANCE TO UKRAINE IS PAUSED! 📣

I am outraged by the direction this Administration's foreign policy has taken towards our strategic partner and ally Ukraine. From voting with Russia, North Korea, and Iran against a UN resolution calling Russia the aggressor, opining that Russia should be in the G7, admonishing President Zelenskyy in the Oval Office meeting, to pausing critical military assistance to Ukraine is dangerous for U.S. national security interests.

For over 11 years, brave Ukrainians have been defending and dying on the frontlines against the Russian aggressor in the name of our shared values. Freedom and democracy are more than just words...It is time to support Ukraine and defend western values.

For CONGRESS:
