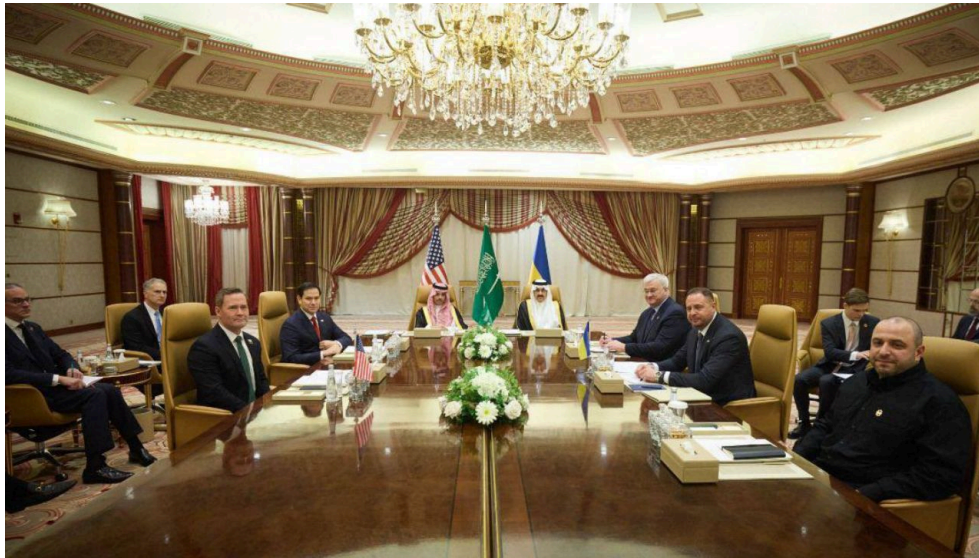

The Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA), representing over 2 million Americans of Ukrainian descent, welcomes all diplomatic efforts aimed at achieving a just and lasting peace for Ukraine. For over 11 years, the people of Ukraine have shown extraordinary courage and resilience in defending Democracy and Ukraine's sovereignty — first against Russia's illegal invasion of Crimea and eastern Ukraine in 2014, and, since 2022, against Russia's full-scale genocidal war.

[High-level discussions](#) in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, between United States and Ukrainian senior officials, following [difficult negotiations in Washington, D.C.](#), focused on the conditions for [continued U.S. support for Ukraine's defense](#). The United States reaffirmed its commitment to immediately [resume military aid](#) and [intelligence sharing](#), both of which are critical to Ukraine's survival. However, UCCA remains deeply concerned that Ukraine is being pressured into accepting a ceasefire that ultimately depends on whether Russia agrees to it.

Russia [has no interest in peace](#) — it wants only the complete destruction of Ukraine. Any intended ceasefire must include robust and enforceable security guarantees for Ukraine. History has repeatedly shown that Russia honors no treaty and respects no agreement — most notably demonstrated

by its [blatant violations of the Minsk Accords](#). A premature or unenforceable ceasefire would only allow russia to regroup and continue its campaign of terror against the Ukrainian people. [Peace must be just](#), and russia must be held fully accountable for all of its [war crimes and acts of genocide](#). The onus is completely placed on russia as it has always been since the start of its aggression against Ukraine.

As Americans, we believe that the United States must continue to stand as a beacon of freedom and democracy. We are proud that our great nation has historically championed these values, and we expect it to remain steadfast in supporting Ukraine's just struggle for its sovereignty, independence, justice, and lasting peace. UCCA is grateful for the support the United States has provided Ukraine and looks forward to the strengthening of the [strategic partnership](#) between the two nations.

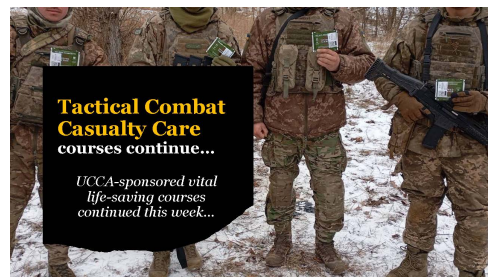
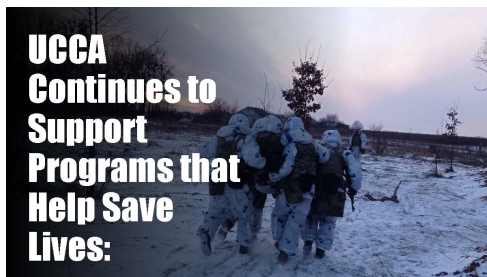


Humanitarian Aid Update

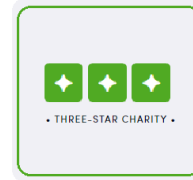

No one wants peace more than Ukraine, but history warns against equating concessions with resolution. Achieving lasting peace in Ukraine demands confronting hard truths – Russia's war is not just about territory, but about ending the existence of a sovereign Ukrainian state and undermining American strength.

Historically, Russia's promises of peace have inevitably led to catastrophe and further bloodshed. This includes its violation of international agreements to which the United States is a signatory, such as the Helsinki Final Act, the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe, the United

The second #StopperKraiev "Ukrainian Week" advocacy event for 2025 will be held during congressional recess from March 17-21, 2025 in local congressional districts and states throughout the country.

Sponsored by the Ukrainian National Information Service (UNIS), the Washington, DC public affairs bureau of the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA), this advocacy event remains an important occasion for the Ukrainian American community on the heels of the successful in-person "Ukrainian Days" in Washington, DC in February 2025.

The weeklong advocacy event from March 17-21, 2025 will be used as an opportunity to meet in person with high-level officials, Senators, and their local staffs in their district and state offices, respectively. We are all under heightened awareness of the current bilateral tensions between Ukraine and the United States. The goal of the in-person advocacy event is to bring focused attention to resolve the U.S. pause of military assistance and intelligence sharing, as well as to remind elected officials that peace in Ukraine must be fair, just, and sustainable with security guarantees.
