# #SUPPORTUKRAINE HUMANITARIAN EFFORT – THREE YEAR REPORT

Since February 24, 2022, when Russia unleashed its unprovoked, full-scale war against Ukraine, the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America (UCCA.org), the largest umbrella organization representing the interests of nearly 2 million Ukrainian Americans, has been providing direct support. For three years now, UCCA has been soliciting, purchasing, delivering, and distributing crucial assistance to Ukraine to help alleviate the humanitarian challenges her people continue to face due to Russia's genocidal invasion, and to support the men and women on the frontline defending democracy against tyranny.

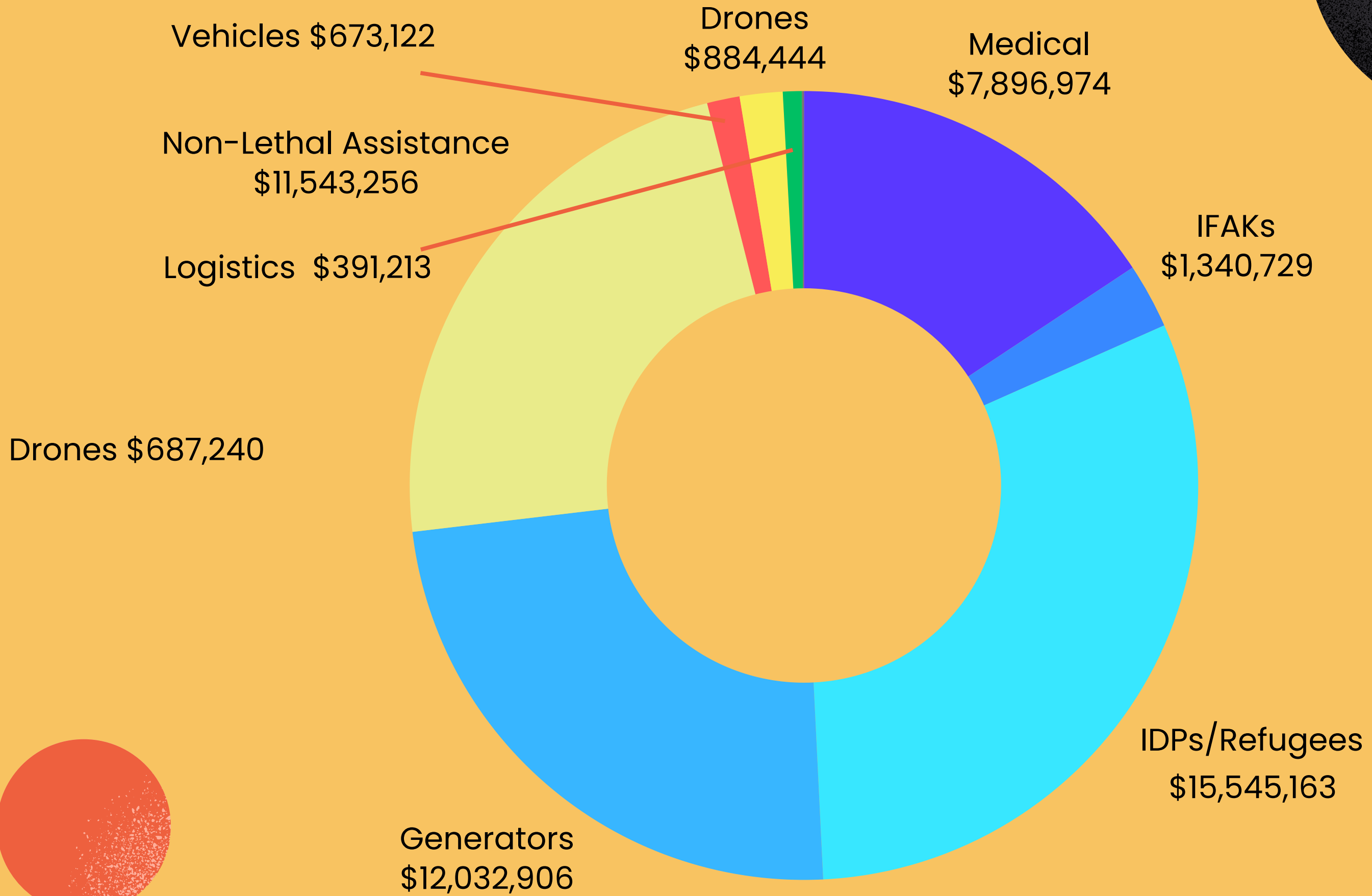


UCCA prides itself in the fact that our aid quickly reaches those in need – nothing is held up in storage and no middlemen. Having a presence in Ukraine for decades, UCCA only works with trusted and vetted partners, including: AICM-Ukraine, Operation White Stork, UCCA Kyiv Bureau, companies such as Bombas, Fieldsheer, LL Bean, medical establishments as Northwell Health Alliance, Globus Relief, Project C.U.R.E, Hospital Sisters Mission Outreach and personalities like celebrity cook and humanitarian Rachael Ray.

UCCA's humanitarian assistance has had a direct impact on thousands of lives in Ukraine. Over the past three years, thanks to the public's trust in and financial support of UCCA's #SupportUkraine program, we have been able to leverage 10x that amount in assistance delivered – resulting in distributing **over \$50million in humanitarian aid and non-lethal assistance**. 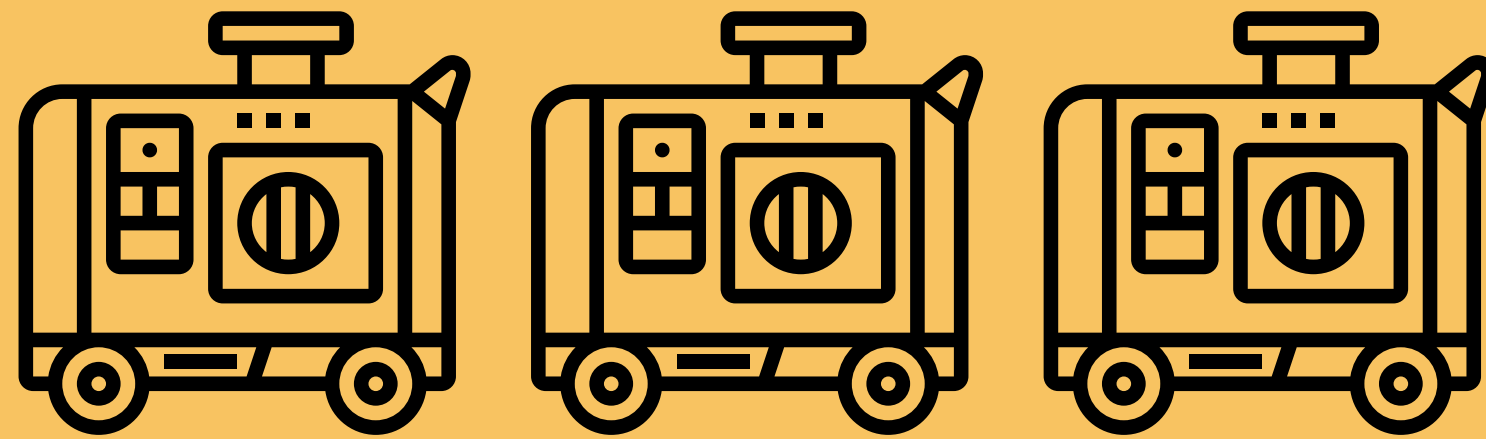


# GENERATORS

## \$12 MILLION



Completed the **distribution of 12,000 portable generators** – the largest donation of its kind – to units defending the frontlines, rehabilitation centers, schools and to civilians returning to newly-liberated towns and villages.



# WARM CLOTHING

**\$5.5  
MILLION**



Secured six in-kind donations of warm winter gear totaling over **\$5.5 million** from Fieldsheer, a technology and apparel company known for its Mobile Warming lines of temperature-controlled clothing- for a total of **147,403 pieces of clothing** including socks, gloves, coats & vests, that were distributed orphans, IDPs and to the men and women on the frontlines.

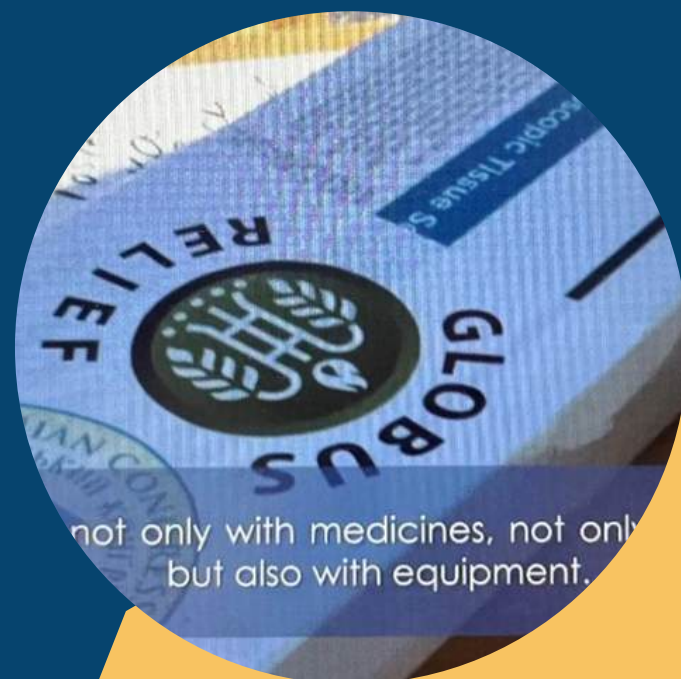
UCCA was able to support Ukraine Focus' "Convoy of Hope" thanks to donors who enabled the delivery of 50 ambulances to Ukraine.

- Secured **\$1.5 million** worth of emergency medical supplies from Globus Relief that were distributed to more than a dozen hospitals in Ukraine.
- Forged a new partnership with Hospital Sisters Mission Outreach, a Medical Supply and Equipment Recovery Organization that enabled UCCA to procure **two 40' containers** filled with vital medical supplies, instruments & much-needed rehabilitation equipment from hospitals across the Midwest. These containers were shipped to our in-country partner who will distribute this vital assistance to various hospitals & clinics serving the wounded.

UCCA continues to procure and deliver humanitarian aid packages filled with medicines, hygiene and food to the elderly and various groups of Internally Displaced Persons.

Regularly **fulfilling non-lethal requests** from units to procure and distribute vitally needed **drones, communications equipment, compasses, GPS equipment**, to help keep the men and women safe on the frontlines.





UCCA earned and maintains its Platinum Seal of Transparency, the highest award from the charity rating organization Candid, formerly known as Guidestar. Candid is the world's largest source of information on nonprofit organizations, and out of non-profits registered in the United States, roughly only 6% receive the Platinum level of transparency. UCCA is also in receipt of Three Star from Charity Navigator ranking us as a standout organization.

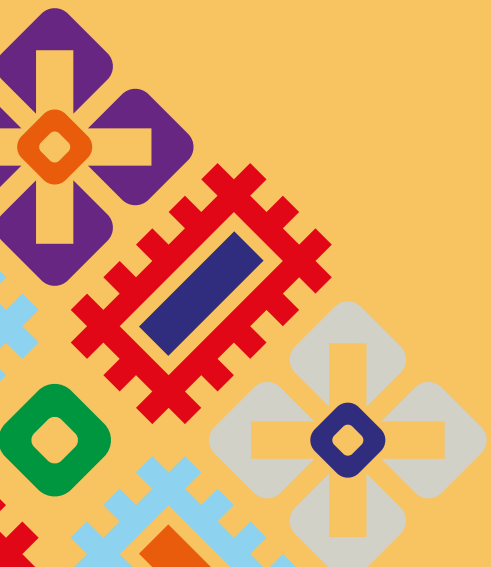

Since the start of the war in February 2022, UCCA has delivered an enormous amount of assistance. To keep our donors and supporters apprised of all the work and aid delivered to Ukraine, UCCA releases weekly Humanitarian Updates. In the 153 weeks of Russia's full-fledged war against Ukraine, UCCA has issued 133 Updates and 17 Special Mission Reports, all of which can be viewed on UCCA's website at <https://ucca.org/aidreports/>. We are proud of our deliverables, and the impact this aid has had on those in need. However, Ukrainians are still standing on the frontlines defending our shared American and Ukrainian democratic values, and they deserve our continued support.
