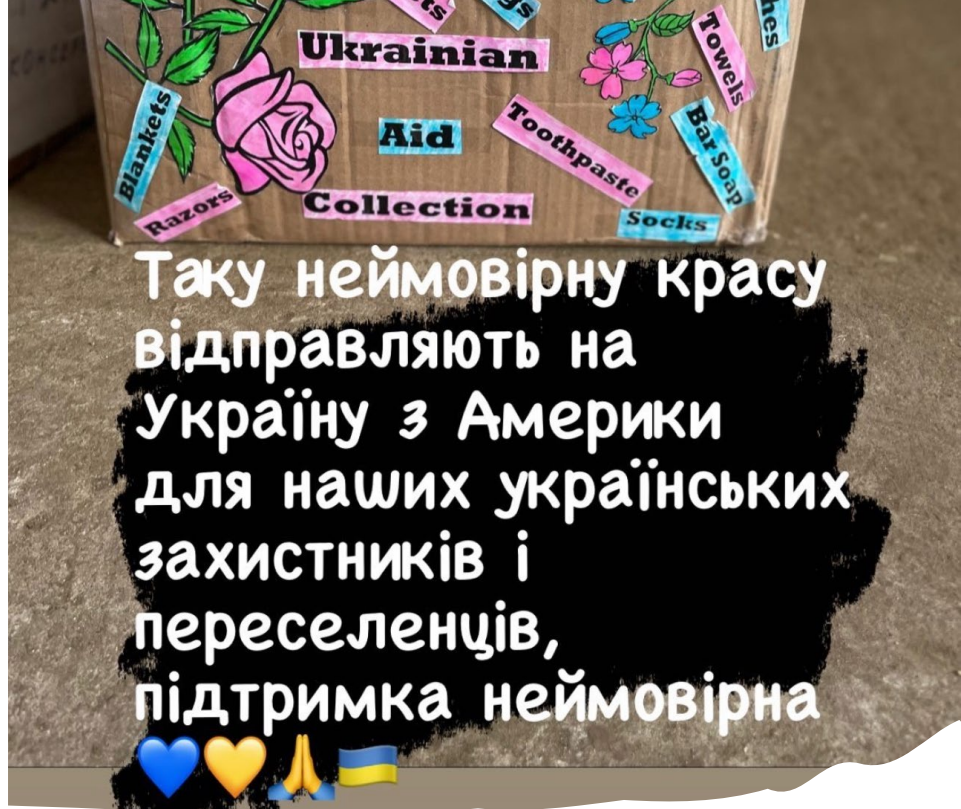

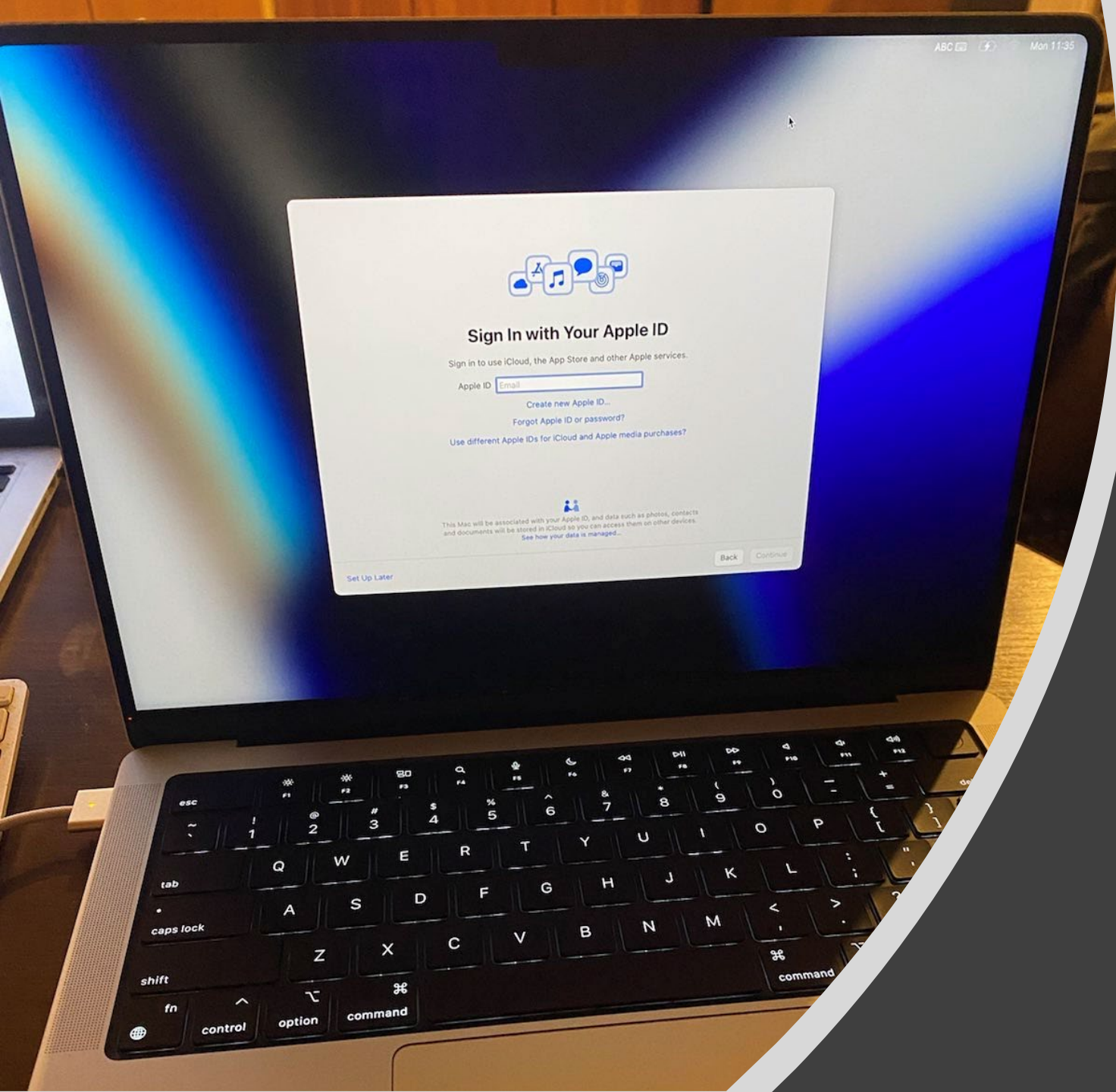

UCCA supports Lyceum #17 of the Lviv City Council Center for IDPs in Lviv

Since the early days of Russia's brutal invasion, Lyceum No. 17 of the Lviv City Council became a shelter for internally displaced persons from the east of Ukraine.

To help Lyceum No.17 support the over 600 people who have sought refuge there, UCCA equipped the school with such necessary items as: 3 shower stalls, tiles, boiler, washing machine, microwave, hygiene products and food.
