Thanks to a solid partnership – UCCA and Rachael Ray have teamed up again to support a cause dear to her heart – helping animals! The genocidal war against Ukraine, has resulted in hundreds of cats and dogs being impacted by russia's constant missile attacks. As a result, UCCA and its Kyiv Bureau have launched two new initiatives ...

Four-Legged Defenders

provides nutritious food to animals, special cages, collars, and veterinary first-aid kits for service dogs, who work with Ukraine's defenders in demining newly liberated territories to help save the lives of both the military and the civilian populations. UCCA works closely with the canine services of the Support Forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, the National Police, the National Guard and the Main Directorate of Intelligence, which have more than 400 service dogs.



Four-Legged Santa

was initiated to help reduce the number of abandoned pets by providing comprehensive assistance to animal shelters and Ukrainians who have pets but because of the war are unable to fully care for them. The program delivers food and medicine for the animals, as well as necessary assistance to the animal shelter's volunteers.





*This week **1.5 tons of pet food** (for cats & dogs) was delivered to our Kyiv warehouse, where it was unloaded. It is now being sorted and prepared for delivery to various animal shelters and owners.*

Several pallets of necessary medications and antibiotics, to keep the cats and dogs healthy, were also delivered to our warehouse.

UCCA 10,000+ Generator Project FINAL UPDATE

UCCA is extremely grateful to our anonymous donor for the enormous gift of portable generators for Ukraine. Over these past 18 months, UCCA has funded the transport of over 12,000 portable generators to Ukraine (ranging from 2,000 – 9,000 kilowatts), while our vetted & trusted partners on the ground have converted the units from the American to European systems, and along with our Kyiv Bureau have distributed them to those who need it most. Generators are now powering destroyed villages, enabling IDPs to stay connected, and most importantly providing much needed power to the men and women on the frontlines defending Ukraine's sovereignty and territorial integrity.





These past two weeks UCCA and its partners have delivered the remaining portable generators to various units...
