Operation Against the Cold:

*As winter's chill grips Ukraine, UCCA is deeply grateful to our largest donor, **#Fieldsheer**, for once again stepping up to support those on the frontlines. This week, three pallets carrying over **\$350,000 worth** of warm socks are scheduled to arrive in Kyiv for distribution.*

Humanitarian Aid Update:

This week UCCA procured and sent vital aid to families who have suffered from the brutal shelling in the Zaporizhzhia, Kharkiv, and Kherson regions. Many have lost their homes and are struggling to meet even their most basic needs.





To support them UCCA is delivering hygiene essentials, much-needed medicines, food supplies, and diapers for people with disabilities who are especially vulnerable. Every box UCCA sends is a small reminder that they are not alone, that we see their pain, and that we stand with them as they try to rebuild their lives.

UCCA continues supporting courses of **Tactical Combat Casualty Care** - a set of evidence-based, battlefield-proven medical guidelines designed to treat combat injuries in the prehospital environment.



Most combat fatalities happen **before** the wounded reach a hospital. TCCC gives trained personnel the tools to treat the leading causes of preventable death—massive bleeding, airway obstruction, and tension pneumothorax.
