UCCA also continues fulfilling vital requests for medicines. This week boxes were sent to Ukraine's freedom fighters in the Kharkiv direction.

Dear Supporters and Friends,

As Russia's ongoing bombardment and deliberate attacks on civilian infrastructure have led to the recent destruction of three major pharmaceutical depots in Kharkiv, the humanitarian crisis is increasingly dire. Disruptions to electricity, communications, and transportation leave civilians under immense strain, while daily air-raids are becoming increasingly dangerous. In these worsening conditions, sustained humanitarian support is essential. We need continual resupply, displaced families rely on access to essential goods, and communities depend on critical non-lethal equipment and medical training.

At the same time, #SupportUkraine has already delivered over \$54 million worth of humanitarian assistance—including more than 12,000 portable generators, millions of blankets, and supplies, over \$7million in warm and heated clothing, among many other things. We are also proud to share that 100% of all monetary donations received by UCCA have been used exclusively to purchase and deliver goods to Ukraine.

Yet at this crucial moment—when the demand for aid is at its highest—overall donations are not creating a significant gap between urgent needs and available resources. This season, your contribution more meaningful and impactful than ever before.

This holiday season, we ask you to consider renewing or increasing your support of our #SupportUkraine Humanitarian Efforts. We respectfully ask you to consider a donation of at least \$100 to help sustain these lifesaving efforts.
