Tourniquets

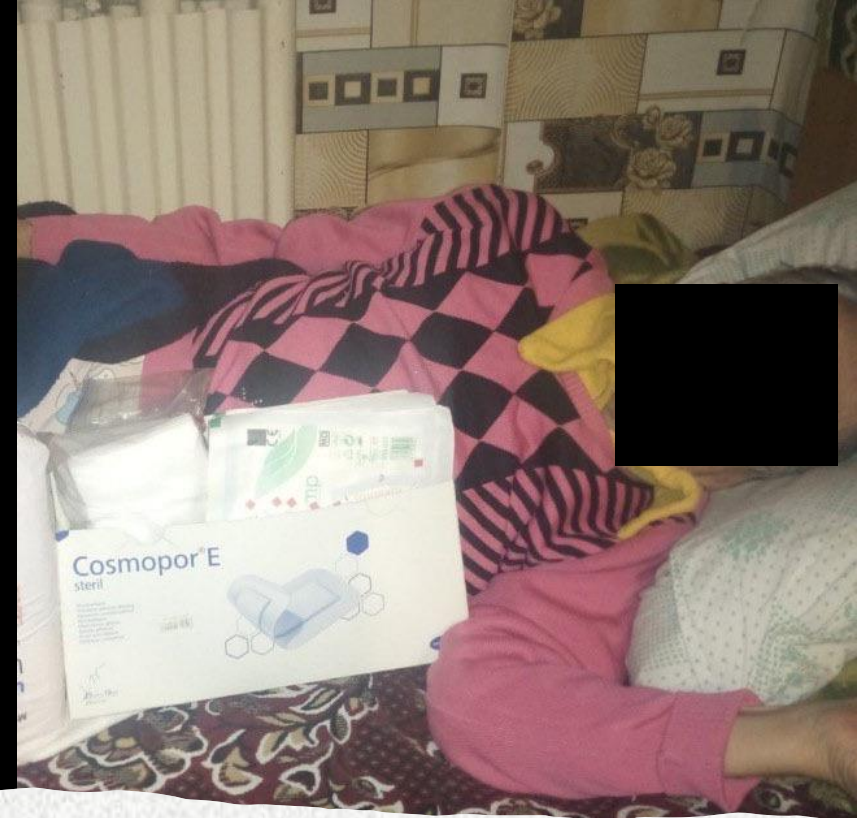
UCCA purchased and delivered 350 tourniquets to our frontline defenders to help save lives.





UCCA is helping the elderly by purchasing, sorting and delivering food, medicines & hygiene products to displaced persons living in a shelter near Kyiv.





These elderly individuals between the ages of 75-85 were evacuated from Donetsk, Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia & Kherson Oblasts, when either their homes were destroyed, or their relatives who cared for them passed away.



Due to the stress of the war some of the elderly IDPs have had a stroke, some have sustained injuries, and some have Alzheimer's or dementia, so...



UCCA tries to provide them some comfort and make them feel at home in the shelter by distributing medicine, food, blankets, wheelchairs, crutches, diapers, detergents, and hygiene products.
