The Ranking Member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, Sen. James Risch (R-ID), has introduced new legislation to bolster support for Ukraine. Referred to as the GUARD (Guaranteeing Ukraine's Autonomy by Reinforcing its Defense) Act, the legislative initiative is currently sponsored by the following senators:

Marco Rubio (R-FL)
Pat Toomey (R-PA)

Rob Portman (R-OH)

Highlights of the bill include \$450 million in Foreign Military Financing (FMF) for Ukraine; enforces sanctions against the NordStream2 political pipeline; designates Russia as a state-sponsor of terror; reaffirms United States commitment to Ukraine's territorial integrity and independence; and, increases military assistance to Ukraine.
