CONTACT CONGRESS NOW!

The White House has announced a request to Congress for an additional \$24 billion in supplemental appropriations for Ukraine. Media outlets are reporting that the presidential request would include \$13.1 billion in additional security and military, with an additional \$8.5 billion for economic and humanitarian assistance to Ukraine.

Currently, the supplemental request is being debated in the U.S. Congress on whether to include the \$24 billion appropriations in a continuing resolution (CR) to avert a federal shutdown.
