Following his trip to New York and his address to the United National General Assembly (UNGA), President Zelensky will travel to Washington, DC to meet with President Biden and congressional leaders. Congress is currently debating the Administration's \$24b supplemental request for Ukraine, the majority of which would be for security assistance. Bipartisan efforts have called for the Biden Administration to supply Ukraine with weaponry that will win the war sooner, including the long-range ATACM missile system.
